## Position Overview and Essential Duties:

This part-time position includes cleaning showers, floors, and other surfaces after a guest has used our services; re-stocking each room according to the needs of the next scheduled guest; folding, sorting, and washing laundry; cleaning bathrooms; sweeping and mopping; vacuuming rugs; taking out trash and recycling; getting inside each float room to sanitize the walls and

water line; cleaning and setting up amenities; restocking supplies; following a task list, checking off tasks, double-checking your work. We provide training on cleaning float room pumps and filters.

We have a fun team, we work hard, and we are proud of the work we do to help people heal. Training provided on all of the tasks.

- Individualized client/float set up throughout the day
- Client services at the front desk include: scheduling sessions, email, phone reception, client check-in/out, asking clients questions, and developing rapport.
